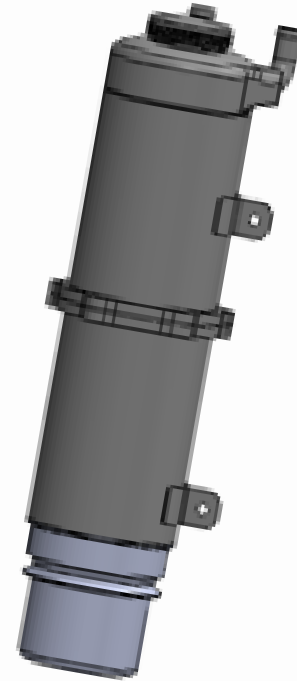
Climbing up Walls

Filter prevents any debris that may fall into the tank when checking oil from entering the engine

Has added benefit of de-aerating the oil (removing foam and bubbles)

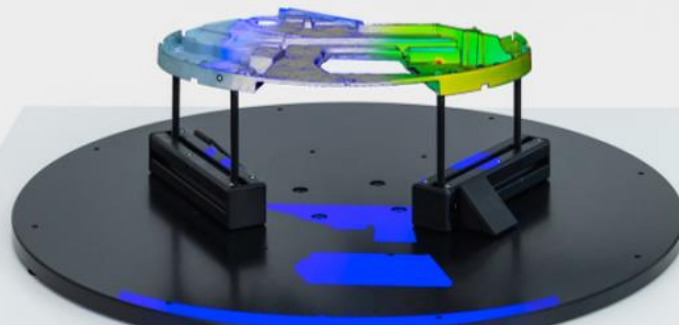

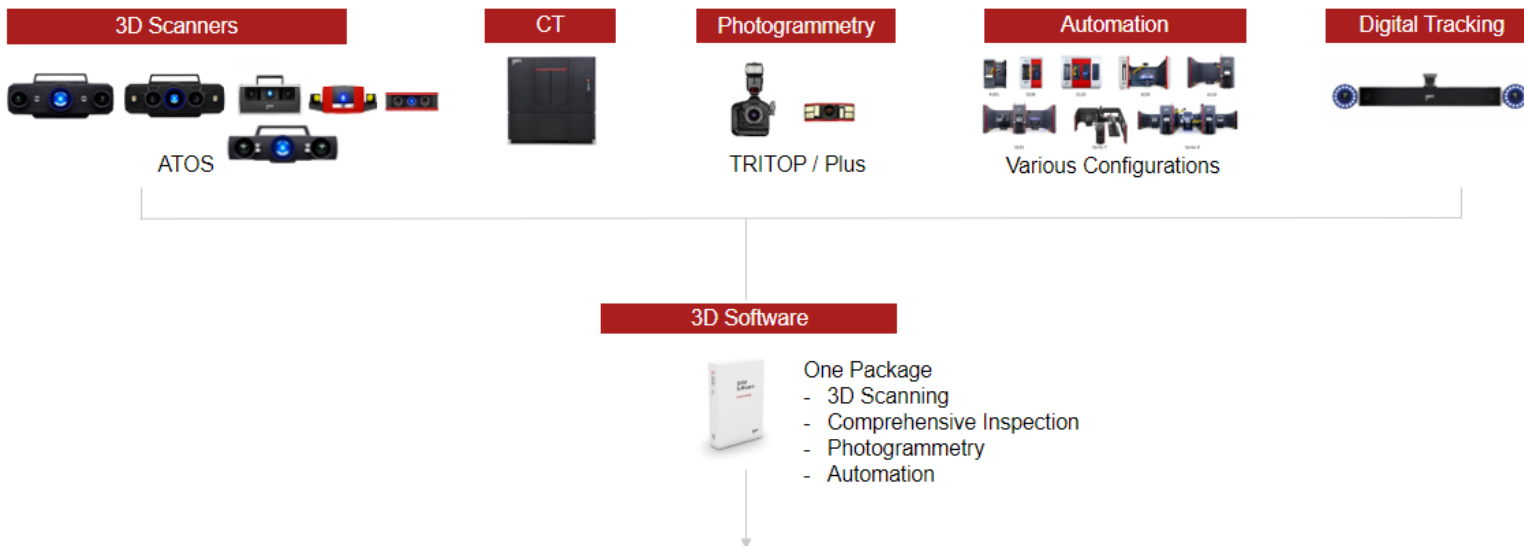
